OPERATIONAL MODALITY FOR FARM MECHANIZATION IN DIRECT BENEFIT TRANSFER (DBT) MODE (2026)

In recent days, the State has done rapid strides in the Farm Mechanization sector. To keep up the rising trend and with the objective of increasing the Farm Power input and to bring it at par with the national level, State Agriculture Policy has provisions for substantial incentives in the form of increased pattern of assistance. The subsidy for Farm Mechanization is being met from different **Centrally Sponsored Schemes i.e. SMAM under PM-RKVY, NFSM** and the **State Plan** scheme namely, “**2078-Popularization of Agricultural Implements, Equipments and Diesel pump sets**”. To bring about greater transparency in the scheme implementation, the State Govt. has decided to implement the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode of subsidy for Farm Machineries, Implements and Equipment including pump sets as per the following Modalities.

The website <http://agrisnetodisha.ori.nic.in/> for implementation of the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode of subsidy for Farm Machineries, Implements and Equipment including pump sets is being hosted and maintained by the Bhubaneswar unit of the National Informatics Centre. The DBT Implements Application Software <https://odishafarmmachinery.nic.in/> is a part of the <http://agrisnetodisha.ori.nic.in/> website. The Technical Team at NIC, Bhubaneswar headed by the Senior Technical Director is operating, maintaining, updating and modifying the Application Software as and when required with due approval of the Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha. Security of the Website/ Application Software and maintaining secrecy of data are sole responsibility of the NIC Team operating the Website/ Software. As successful implementation of “Farm Mechanisation DBT” depends on effective running of the DBT Implements Application Software, the Senior Technical Director, NIC, Bhubaneswar will closely monitor the Computer Programming job undertaken by his/ her team, regularly audit the programming job to rule out any sort of Human errors/ Technical errors and ensure proper interpretation of the Executive Orders / Instructions issued from the Directorate of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha from time to time for updating/ maintaining / incorporating instructions in the Website/ Application software through appropriate computer programming. The Website/ Application Software are designed to be User Friendly and on the other hand, it needs to be sturdy and impervious to Invaders and Malwares, both animate and inanimate.

Go-Sugam <https://sugam.odisha.gov.in/> portal is the single window platform for farmers to apply for assistance under DBT- Farm Mechanisation. Aligning with the Government of Odisha’s vision of governance, Sugam portal aims to transform the lives of farmers by leveraging technology and fostering teamwork among government officials to enable timely and transparent delivery of benefits to the farmers. All farmer-centric schemes and services of the Department of Agriculture & Farmer Empowerment (DAFE), Government of Odisha are digitized on the Sugam Portal. The application interface of <https://odishafarmmachinery.nic.in/> has been integrated with Go-Sugam [https://sugam.odisha.gov.in.](https://sugam.odisha.gov.in/)

1: PATTERN OF ASSISTANCE

The Machineries / Implements/ Equipment of different Firms approved by the State Level Technical Committee (SLTC) are eligible under subsidy fold as per the Pattern of Assistance Approved by Agriculture & F.E. Department, Government of Odisha.

2: ELIGIBILITY OF FARMERS

2.1 Every individual farmer registered with Krushak Odisha & Go-Sugam, possessing a **valid Farmer ID, AADHAAR card and a valid mobile number** irrespective of his or her land holdings is eligible for subsidy. Registered Farmers' Groups like Pani Panchayats /Vana Surakshya Samities / Registered NGOs / Co-Operative Societies /Self Help Groups (SHG)/ Women's Selfhelp Groups (WSHG) etc. are also eligible for purchase of different Agricultural Machinery /Equipment/ Implements under subsidy. In case of a group, a nominated individual will be the applicant. The nominated individual should have valid Farmer ID, mobile number and AADHAAR card. Under the DBT Farm Mechanisation Scheme, an eligible farmer/ beneficiary is allowed to purchase. Multiple subsidies for same implement/machine will be allowed after the moratorium period (5years) of the machine. The reduced subsidy pattern for multiple subsidies will be @ 100%, 75% and 50% of the pattern of assistance for 1st, 2nd and 3rd time purchase respectively.

2.2 As a preliminary step all the farmers having **ADHAAR** No. in the universe of Farmers' database need to be validated from UIDAI. If a farmer ID does not have **AADHAAR** in the data base, a prompt will be given to the applicant in the application stage to validate / input **AADHAAR** No. freshly in the farmer database through respective Block AAO/ BAO.

2.3 **Government** of Odisha is now giving more and more emphasis for Women Empowerment by way of providing them opportunities to uplift their socio-economic status. Agriculture and Farmers' Empowerment Department is also empowering Women in Agriculture through various innovative interventions and livelihood supports. Providing Farm Machineries/ Implements/ Equipment on subsidy is one among many such interventions of the Department. Registered Women's Selfhelp Groups can avail subsidy for purchase of selected commercially viable Farm Machineries/ Implements/ Equipment through online DBT mode for their sustainability. The WSHG having valid Wshg-ID approved by the respective CDPO represented through nominated / authorized member of the group (Secretary / President in whose name the Bank Account of the group is being operated) has to apply online in the Go-Sugam portal.

3: REGISTRATION & CONFIRMATION OF MANUFACTURERS / DEALERS.

The procedure for implementation and procurement of different Machineries / Implements concerning to different schemes will be made as per the following stipulations.

3.1 Only machines approved by SLTC are eligible for enlistment on the Odisha Farm Machinery portal for subsidy sales. The Director of Agriculture & Food Production, Odisha issues online EOI notices for SLTC empanelment in tendersodisha site and leading newspapers, which is also published on the Agrisnet Odisha and Odisha Farm Machinery portals.

Interested manufacturers must register by uploading the required documents and credentials at **ofmrhc.odisha.gov.in**. The uploaded documents will be duly verified with respective originals by the Development Engineer (DE) at OFMRDC, Bhubaneswar. Once the DE approves the manufacturer profiles, they will be allowed to add implements for approval during the EOI period.

To ensure consistency and uniformity, the name of the manufacturing company will be aligned with the trade name of the firm as registered under GST.

Subsequently implements approved through online SLTC mode will be synchronized from OFMRDC portal to the odishafarmmachinery portal after execution of the Service Level Agreement (SLA) with DE, OFMRDC.

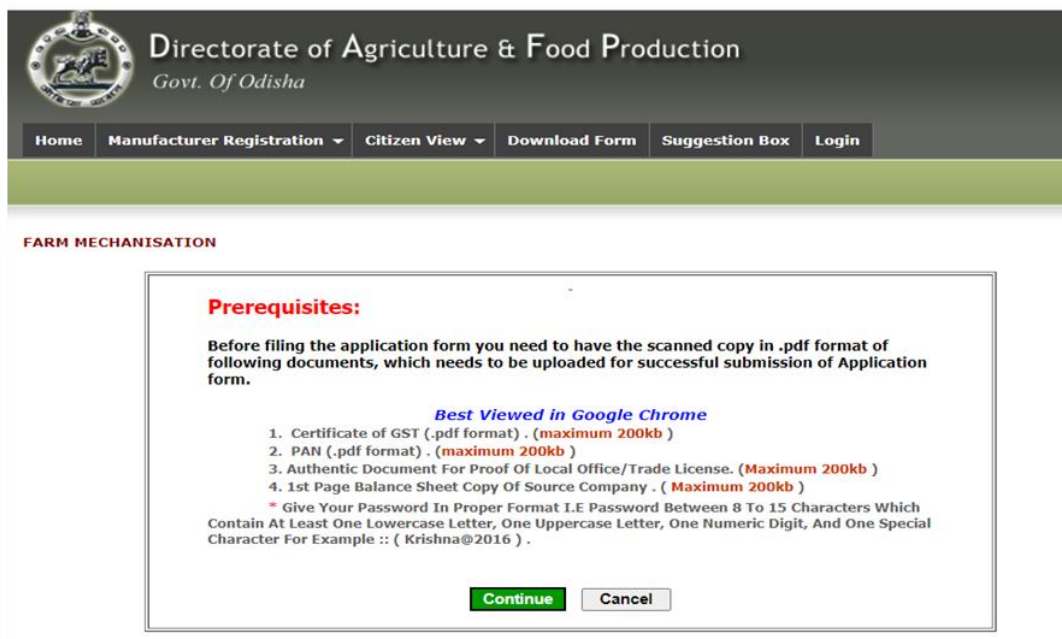
The Manufacturers of the existing SLTC approved Machinery / Equipment if not registered online at ofmrhc.odisha.gov.in, will have to get them registered and get their Manufacturer profiles approved by the Development Engineer (DE), OFMRDC, Bhubaneswar. The SLA Validity & Commercial Test Report (CTR) validity will be incorporated by the DE, OFMRDC.

3.2 The Login credentials i.e. the Login ID, Password, Registered e-mail ID and the Registered Mobile Numbers of the Manufacturer are important personal asset of the Manufacturer concerned. It is their Personal/ Institutional responsibility to keep these credentials confidential to avoid any sort of misuse by anyone. If in anyway, due to misuse of the Login credentials, there is any sort of financial/ social loss to any of the stake holders (like Farmers/Public/Government) under the Domain of DBT Implements, that will be treated as sole Personal/ Institutional liability of the Manufacturer and in all such cases, Legal action as deemed fit will be taken against the Firm by the Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha.

3.3 On every occasion the Manufacturer logs in to the <https://odishafarmmachinery.nic.in/> page, a system generated OTP will be sent by the NIC to the Registered Mobile Number of

the Manufacturer. IP address of the Manufacturer Login will be closely and vigilantly monitored by the NIC so that multiple logging in by a Manufacturer from various locations and by different individuals at a particular time or by fraudulent invaders can be monitored and checked. In such events, the site may be locked for access to the Manufacturer for 24 hours or more time if the Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha feels that multiple logging in by the Manufacturer is done with ill intentions.

- 3.4 The Manufacturer is required to change his login Password as frequently as he may feel necessary to safeguard his interest. However, it will be mandatory for the Manufacturer to change the Password once in every 90 (ninety) days and for that he will be prompted by the system at least 7 (seven) days before expiry of the Password.

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3.6 In the next step, the Manufacturers will mention their ex-factory price, dealer billing price and MRP (**which in no case should exceed the MRP of the particular Implement/ Machinery prevailing in the neighbouring states and all other states of the Country**) in the on-line field. Simultaneously they shall have to upload the proof of GST return against the ex-factory cost. The Registered dealers will upload their sale price which should not be more than the MRP for the SLTC approved Machineries/Equipment. The dealer billing price quoted by the manufacturer and sale price of different dealers for that particular machine will be visible to the farmers.

3.7 The Manufacturers / Dealers will be allowed by the Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha to revise / update the MRP of different Farm Machineries/ Implements/ Equipment online in the website only once in a financial year. Subsequent upward revision of MRP is not allowed. However, in any case if the Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha feels that the MRPs of some or all the Farm Machineries/ Implements/ Equipment need to be revised further during the year, he may allow the Manufacturers/ Dealers to do so. In both the cases, specific time slot will be given to the Manufacturers/ Dealers to revise the MRPs and a Scroll to that effect will be displayed in the Login page of the Manufacturers/ Vendors in the website.

3.8 In order to verify the rationality of different costs mentioned in the Manufacturer as well as the Dealer page and to fix the Indicative costs for various SLTC approved Machineries/ Implements/ Equipment, a designated committee consisting of the following members at State level will go through all the documents related to costing and vet the costs of Manufacturer & Dealer.

State Level Committee for Price Monitoring:

1. Chief Engineer (Agril.) - Chairman
2. Agriculturist, Govt. of Odisha, A&FE Department
3. Joint Commissioner, Bhubaneswar Range, Commercial Tax and GST
4. F.A. cum CAO, O/o DA&FP(O)
5. Joint Director, EPM
6. Director, SLFMTTC, Bhubaneswar
7. DEAN, CAET, OUAT, Bhubaneswar
8. Superintending Engineer (Agril.), Central Zone, Bhubaneswar
9. Managing Director, OAIC Ltd.
10. Development Engineer, OFMRDC- Member Convener

The State Level Committee for Price Monitoring will sit twice in a year or more frequently if required by the Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha in the interest of Public Service. The Committee will give its recommendations regarding **finalization of MRP** of the manufacturers and also **Indicative Cost** for SLTC Approved Machineries/ Equipment/ Implements to the Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha for approval before implementing.

The Price Monitoring Committee will also review & recommend the Pattern of Assistance of different machines suitable for propagation in the State, in line with the SMAM pattern communicated by MoA for perusal & approval by Government in A & FE Department.

3.9 New dealers can register themselves at <http://agrisnetodisha.ori.nic.in/> or <https://odishafarmmachinery.nic.in/>. Besides filling up the scheduled registration form available on the dealer registration link of the Farm Mechanization Home page, they have to furnish documents like up-to-date GST clearance and the Dealership Certificate of the Manufacturer, Aadhar, PAN, Photo and account details. The above documents will be verified by the Executive Engineers (Agril) of the respective Districts / Agricultural Engineering Divisions and after confirmation; they can login to the system with their user ID and password.

3.10 **On every occasion the Dealer logs in to the** <https://odishafarmmachinery.nic.in/> page, a system generated OTP will be sent by the NIC to the Registered Mobile Number of the Dealer. IP address of the Dealer Login will be closely and vigilantly monitored by the NIC so that multiple logging in by a Dealer from various locations and by different individuals at a particular time or by fraudulent invaders can be monitored and checked. In such events, the site may be locked for access to the Dealer for 24 hours or more time if the Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha feels that multiple logging in by the Dealer is done with ill intentions.

3.11 The Dealer is required to change his login Password as frequently as he may feel necessary to safeguard his interest. However, it will be mandatory for the Dealer to change the Password once in every 90 (ninety) days and for that he will be prompted by the system at least 7 (seven) days before expiry of the Password.

3.12 Manufacturers will choose their respective dealers through the group dealer link. After grouping, the Manufacturer will distribute the Engine Nos./ Chassis Nos., Standardized unique identification code (SUIC) of different Machineries among the dealers which will be in **read-only** format. The time limit for uploading the Engine Nos./ Chassis Nos, SUIC in portal to the dealer is 30 days from the date of billing by either the manufacturer or the distributor. In cases where the billing to the dealer is made through distributor, it should be within 365 days of billing by the manufacturer to distributor. Manufacturer will upload the scanned copy of the original bills /invoice raised in favour of the concerned dealers. For distribution of machines through Distributors, he will have to upload the Distributor billing and Dealer billing rose by distributors. In case of machineries sourced from other countries the **bill of entry** should invariably uploaded along with the invoices raised to dealers.

The dealer has to maintain the minimum stock which needs to be reflected in portal. Permits will only be generated basing on the availability of stock. In cases where farmer's payment is successful, but supply couldn't be effected within the permit validity period, the said machine will be kept in hold till supply to that beneficiary.

All the related bills uploaded by the Manufacturer will be visible to the Executive Engineer (Agril)/Assistant Executive Engineer (Agril)/Assistant Agriculture Engineer for random verification at dealers' points. During verification they will also verify the veracity of the bills uploaded, stock position at dealer point, Technical Specifications etc.

3.13 In case of Tractors, Odisha Agro Industries Corporation Ltd. (OAIC) will upload the Sale Price of Tractors through its District Managers for the respective districts.

3.14 OAIC, by default, would be the dealers for all other implements throughout the State of Odisha.

4: UPLOADING OF TARGET

4.1 The Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha will allot up to 35-50% of the category/ scheme wise target of Farm Machineries / Equipment to each district basing on the budgetary provisions and / or demand from field in shape of requisition made by the CDAO/ Executive Engineer (Agril.) of the respective districts. Executive Engineers (Agril.) of concerned district will distribute the allotted targets to each Block. The target fixed for the Block will be split into the target for different categories (Normal, SCP and TASP categories). The inclusion of WSHG target **limiting upto @ 33%** across all categories with a subsidy provision of 75% of the respective pattern of assistance for the **selected commercially viable machines** will be there. The details of District-wise and Block-wise target will be made available in the CITIZENS VIEW.

4.3 In case of higher demand of a particular Machinery/ Equipment in a particular district and if the district target for such Machinery/ Equipment is exhausted, the CDAO/ EE (Agril.) of the concerned district will request the Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha in writing for enhancing the target. The Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha may re-distribute the target of that particular Machinery/ Equipment among the districts keeping the State target intact.

4.4 To take care of the demand of particular category & block requirement, **District Pool** Target has been provisioned. Up to 30-35% of budget provision will be allotted to **District Pool**. The District Pool will be topped up by Admin / DA&FP (O) basing on requirement.

4.5 A **State Pool** target has been provisioned to take care of the unforeseen demand of implement / machine for particular category and events (i.e. Melas on Farm Mechanisation etc.). Up to 20-30% of budget provision will be kept in **State Pool**. This will be a reserve to ensure availability of all implements under all categories at any point of time/season for the interested farmers.

4.6 If the demand for Farm Mechanization cannot be met within the category wise (i.e. Normal, SCP & TASP) target fixed for the State, the Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha will move the State Government in A&FE Department for enhancing the physical target and also for making additional category wise (i.e. Normal, SCP & TASP) provision of funds, if required.

4.7 In exigencies, the Admin i.e. the Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha can re-appropriate/re-allocate the assigned targets amongst the Districts/Blocks as well as the targeted machinery.

5: APPLICATION/BOOKING AND ISSUE OF PERMIT

5.1 Any applicant registered with Krushak Odisha & Go-Sugam having a **valid Farmer ID Mobile Number** and **AADHAAR No.** can apply by log-in through Go-Sugam <https://sugam.odisha.gov.in> in the online system for booking of the machine of his requirement. Farmer will book the Implement/ Machinery in the system using his Farmer ID and Aadhaar No. A system generated OTP will be sent to the Registered Mobile Number and on validation he will be able to book the implement if target is available and can print booking-id.

5.2 Registered Women's Self-help Groups having valid Wshg-ID can avail subsidy for purchase of Farm Machineries / Implements/ Equipment through online DBT mode. The nominated/ authorized member of the group (Secretary/ President/ any other member in whose name, the Bank Account of the group is being operated) can apply by log-in through Go-Sugam <https://sugam.odisha.gov.in>.

5.3 In the case where financial assistance in shape of subsidy is to be provided to WSHGs for purchase of Farm Machineries / Equipment under the Component "Agri-ventures by supplying

Farm Machineries” in convergence with Mission Shakti Department (under State Plan Schemes or any CSS/ CSP Schemes as may be decided by the Government from time to time), eligibility and selection criteria of the WSHGs will be governed by the Guidelines/ Modalities issued vide letter No. DAFE-SCHM-MISC-0002-2021/20738 dt.27.10.2021 of the Government of Odisha in A&FE Department, along with its amendments/ revisions/ modifications from time to time.

5.4 Booking: In all the cases, this online booking of Farm Machineries/ Implements/ Equipment will be saved in favour of applicant for **10 days**. Consequent upon introduction of State Pool target, multiple bookings may be considered up to subsidy limit of Rs. 2.00 lakhs or 3 machines whichever less is.

One time change of type of sub implements after booking prior to generation of permit within the validity period is admissible.

5.5 Permit: For generation of permit, he/she will choose the make & model of the machinery as per own choice carefully observing the price quoted by the vendor. He/she will also choose the dealer of own choice out of the enlisted dealers for that district. During choosing the dealer by the applicant, an SMS will be sent to the dealer for his consent. The applicant will be in contact with the dealer to negotiate the best offer price. The dealer has to provide the offer price within the day of getting the SMS failing which, permit will be generated with the price as indicated by him in the portal by default on the next day.

The make & model of the machinery once chosen can be changed only once after permit generation within 25 days of issue of permit.

The above changes are validated only through the OTP sent to the applicant's registered mobile number.

5.6 Procedure for “Payment successful but the supply failed” cases

1. Initial Revalidation Request by Dealer

- a. The dealer shall initiate a revalidation request through his/her login for the concerned permit.

- b. Upon submission, the system will automatically extend the permit validity by **15 days** (i.e., original validity of 30(self-finance)/45(Loan) days + 15 days).
- 2. **Second Revalidation** (Post-Lapse of First Revalidation Period)
 - a. If the dealer fails to supply within the first revalidation period, he/she may apply for a second revalidation **after the permit validity has expired**, selecting a valid reason from the dropdown menu, such as:
 - i. *Beneficiary did not turn up*
 - ii. *Dealer was unavailable/could not supply*
 - b. Upon admin approval, the permit validity will be extended for an additional **15 days** (i.e., 30/45 + 15 + 15 days).
- 3. **Restriction After Two Revalidations**
 - a. If the dealer fails to complete the supply even after two revalidations, he/she will be **restricted from generating new permits** until all pending supplies are completed.
- 4. **Timeline-Based Restriction for Unsupplied Cases**
 - a. If supply is not completed within the following timelines:
 - i. **60 days** for *self-finance cases*
 - ii. **75 days** for *loan-cases*
 - b. The dealer will be automatically **barred from generating any new permits** until all overdue supplies are successfully completed.

5.7 As permits are system generated documents, no signature is required. After online generation of permit, the beneficiary will proceed to the registered vendor chosen by him/her and take delivery of the machine paying its full cost.

In **Self Finance Case**: Payment will be made from the farmer-id validated Bank Account of the beneficiary to the account of DA&FP, Odisha through Payment Gateway. The applicant can choose the Net Banking mode or e-challan mode as per his/her convenience.

In case of **Loan**:

The following message to be mentioned in the permit “The financing Bank / NBFC is requested to mail copy of the Delivery Order to the Executive Engineer (Agril.) and CDAO of the district mail IDs” (*The EE (Agril.) and CDAO mail id to be fetched from mapped database*)

The applicant will contact the financing Bank / NBFC along with the permit. After a Loan amount is sanctioned in favour of the Loanee (Farmer), it is transferred by the Financing Institution directly to the Dealer and an online generated Delivery Order is given to the Dealer in support of disbursed loan amount.

A copy of the “Delivery Order” is to be mailed to the Executive Engineer (Agril.) of the division and CDAO of the district by the concerned *Bank/ NBFC*.

The farmer after getting a copy of the Delivery Order from the Bank/ NBFC, will proceed to the concerned dealer with valid Permit.

The Dealer will update the Delivery Order details against the permit in the appropriate field (i.e. Applicant name, Machine Name, DO reference No...date, Disbursed amount, name

of sanctioning Bank/NBFC). Upload the Delivery Order through Dealer Log in. (*Dealers should be careful in uploading the “Delivery Order” details by cross checking the permit details*).

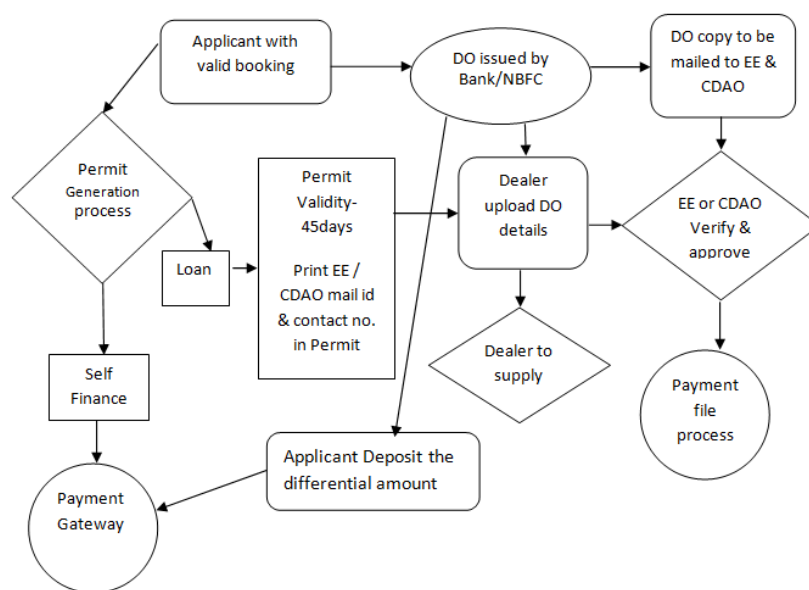
The applicant will deposit the differential amount/margin money if any (*i.e. Full cost mentioned in permit less disbursed amount mentioned in Delivery Order*) through Payment Gateway.

The process of deposit of cost of machine, supply & delivery etc. should be completed within the stipulated time i.e. validity of permit (i.e. **45 days only in Loan cases**).

After uploading of Delivery Order by the dealer, the same will be shown to respective Executive Engineer of Division and CDAO of the district, who will match the details with the mailed copy of Bank / NBFC and approve the same in his log – in **on daily basis**.

*The subsidy payment file will be generated / processed only after approval of the loan details **either** by the Executive Engineer (Agril.) **or** CDAO of the district.*

N.B.: Loan application & sanction should be done well ahead by the applicant prior to booking of implements so as to complete the issue of Delivery Order within the validity period of Permit.

Financial Transactions that may occur between the Farmer/ Beneficiary/ Group and the Dealer in any mode and for any other purpose other than that mentioned as above is at their own risk and responsibility and Government in no way will be responsible for possible outcomes of such transactions.

5.8 e-RUPI has been introduced for procurement of Farm Machinery & Irrigation pump sets : The Standard Operating Procedure has already been communicated through this office letter no. 7411 dt.25.02.2025.

5.9 Zero transaction will not be allowed in any case. Farmers without valid Krushak Odisha, Go-Sugam & Farmer's ID won't be able to generate permit.

5.10 Tractor Driven Implements will be allowed under subsidy only to a beneficiary who owns a tractor. He/ she will be prompted by the system to enter the Registration Number of the tractor in the online application page at the time of booking. The Registration Number of the tractor will be validated by the Odisha Motor Vehicle Department through VAHAAN and the genuine Tractor Owner will only be eligible to get subsidy for the Tractor Driven Implement. Tractor Registration Number for that particular implement will be locked. (i.e. same implement cannot be availed for that RC again).

5.11 Validity of the booking **10 (ten)** days and permit is **30 (thirty)** or **45 (forty-five)** days for self-finance or Loan from the date of online generation. Normally, **there would be no revalidation of any permit for whatever the reason may be.** In case of permits lapsed with successful payments, the engine / chassis nos, SUIC will be locked till revalidation and subsequent supply of machinery, other than tractor. The farmer with a lapsed booking or permit will have to apply again for a permit for the desired Implement **after (3) three months** from the date of expiry of last permit. However, if in any case the Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha feels that one or more permits generated during a particular period need to be revalidated (in situations like Natural Calamities/ Disasters/ Pandemics/ Endemics/ Emergencies/System technical snags, etc.); he may at his discretion allow revalidation of such permits for a period of **15 (fifteen) days.** Allow rebooking for lapsed bookings or permits where payment has not been made. In cases of permits where successful transaction through payment gateway is done on the last minute/day and supply could not be affected within the validity period, only such permits will be revalidated for a period of **15 (fifteen) days.**

5.12 The Registered Vendors should make arrangement for pre-positioning of Stocks so that the Machinery can be supplied immediately after issue of permits. The dealers should be careful enough to mention the machine and transaction details online, as subsidy will go to the farmers validated Bank Account directly (DBT).

6: PROCUREMENT OF THE MACHINERY / IMPLEMENT

6.1 In the event of the death of a beneficiary occurring after successful payment for the machinery/tractor but before the completion of online supply (biometric authentication/R.C. entry), the disbursement of subsidy shall be processed in favor of the legitimate legal heir. The detailed Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for such cases—

including document requirements such as the Legal Heir Certificate, No Objection Certificate (NOC), and the verification process by the District Level Committee —has been established and communicated via **Directorate Letter No. 42529, dated 08-12-2025.**

- 6.2 The Vendor/ Dealer, on physical supply of the equipment, will supply the bill; guarantee card and user manual to the beneficiary. He will upload two photographs in the GPS enabled camera, i.e. 1) machine with beneficiary and dealer 2) Close-up photograph of the Engine Number and Chassis Number through Mobile Application-FM DBT (to be downloaded from Goggle Play Store)/web mode. He may also take the photo through Mobile Phone in offline mode and synchronize it afterwards when internet connection is available.
- 6.3 The Vendor/ Dealer, after synchronizing the photo details through Mobile App, will submit the machine and transaction details in his online field.
- 6.4 The Vendor/ Dealer will enter his/ her Retail Invoice / Tax Invoice number in the space provided for the purpose after which an automated bill will be generated by the system. The Vendor will hand over the copy of the two bills to the farmer. Retail Invoice/ Tax Invoice number will also be reflected in the system generated bill for future reference.
- 6.5 In case of tractors and wheel type Combine Harvesters, the registered vendor will give the Registration Certificate (R.C) detail.

7: MANUFACTURER VALIDATION OF SUPPLY:

The details of machine/implements (i.e. Engine Number/ Chassis number/Serial No./SUIC) supplied by the vendor/dealer against the permit will have to be validated by the respective Manufacturer.

8: EFFECTIVE OWNERSHIP OF THE MACHINERY /IMPLEMENTS / EQUIPMENT

A beneficiary who avails the subsidy for purchase of an Implement/ Machinery/ Equipment would **submit a declaration** to the effect that “I shall keep the Implement/ Machinery/ Equipment in my physical possession for a minimum period as stipulated here:

Tractor / Combine Harvester etc.-	5 (five) years
Power Tiller / Reaper / Transplanter /	5 (five) years
Self- Propelled Post Harvest Machineries etc.	

Other Machineries / Implements / Equipment- 5 (five) years
(Except manual and bullock drawn implements)

Any form of disposal within the stipulated period will invite recovery of subsidy from me by Government of Odisha through **OPDR** (Odisha Public Demands Recovery) **Act.**”

The BAO/AAO (HQ) of the Block will initiate OPDR case against the defaulter persons those who deviate the above Guidelines.

9: RELEASE OF SUBSIDY:

Subsidy will be released by the designated Banks directly to the validated Bank Account of the beneficiary through Bank Aggregator System Application (BAS) (common banking platform) or PFMS (Public Financial management System) within 3 – 7 (Three-Seven) working days.

10: INSPECTION, VERIFICATION, ENFORCEMENT, MONITORING AND EVALUATION:

10.1 Post Delivery Inspection: All the Farm Machineries/ Implements/ Equipments supplied through subsidy under Farm Mechanisation DBT Mode will be done through FMN App for the implements as follows:

- i. All implements except tractors having subsidy amount of Rs.1,00,000/- and above
- ii. 50% of the implements having subsidy amount of Rs. 75,000/- to < Rs. 1,00,000/-
- iii. 30% of the implements having subsidy amount of Rs. 50,000/- to < Rs. 75,000/-
- iv. 10% of the implements having subsidy amount of < Rs. 50,000/-

The PDI to be done by the Asst. Agril. Engineer @83%, Asst. Executive Engineer (Agril.) @17% respectively.

1. Out of 30 districts, EE (Agril.)'s head quarter is placed in 17 districts. For the rest 13 districts, the AEEs will verify the rejected cases of AAE, 3rd party along with his share of PDI.

2. In districts with more blocks/geographical area/ potentially higher mechanisation (i.e Ganjam, Bargarh, Keonjhar, Mayurbhanj, Kalahandi and Sundergarh) the head quarter sub division's all rejected cases will be verified by EE and for other subdivisions concerned AEE will verify the rejected cases of AAE and 3rd party along with his share of PDI.

3. The rejected cases of AEEs will be checked by the respective EE of the division and take action against the defaulters as per SOP communicated.

On the last day of every month, NIC Bhubaneswar will generate beneficiary data on the basis mentioned above for each district; randomize the data as per the proportion and make available in the respective pages of AAE, AEE & EE in the mobile App.

10.2 PDI – Automated Debarment and Revival Mechanism:

10.2.1. Auto-Debarment Criteria Based on Rejection Reasons:

Dealer ID and Farmer ID shall be automatically scored with given “% chance for debarment touches” basing on the PDI reason of rejection in the App by respective AAEs & AEEs as detailed below:

Sl. No.	Reason of Rejection	% chance for debarment of a particular Dealer ID (Per Rejected PDI Case)	% chance for debarment of a particular Farmer ID (Per Rejected PDI Case)
1	Machine not supplied	20%	50 %
2	Machine sold by the beneficiary	15%	100 %
3	Machine supplied but not shown by the beneficiary	10%	50 %
4	Beneficiary not traceable	33%	100 %
5	Machine not purchased / Beneficiary ignorant about machine	15 %	50 %
6	Engine No. / Chassis No. mismatch	10 %	N.A.

Once the sum of “% of chance for debarment” of a particular Dealer ID/Farmer ID reaches $\geq 100\%$ the respective ID will be automatically debarred from Farm Mechanisation portal till next level verification by the respective EE.

10.2.2. Way forward:

i. Rejection by AAE/AEE:

- Rejected cases shall be assigned to the EE for verification.
- If the EE confirms availability of the machine, equivalent score of “% of chance for debarment” will be assigned for “% of chances of revival” for that particular permit, both Farmer ID and Dealer ID shall be revived from the Debar List when the cumulative score of “% of chance for debarment” is $< 100\%$ for respective cases.

ii. Rejection Confirmed by EE:

- Both Dealer ID and Farmer ID shall be **blocked**.
- The respective case shall be assigned for **Joint Verification Committee** as per this office letter No. **16676 dated 22.04.2024**.
- The EE shall intimate blocking of the Farmer ID to the concerned **CDAO**. Respective CDAO will issue show cause notice &, if necessary, initiate steps for action as per Point- 8, Operational Modality.

iii. Outcome of Joint Verification

- If the Joint Verification Committee reports positively, the Dealer ID shall be recommended by EE for removal from the Blocked List.

10.2.3. Action against Defaulting Manufacturers:

- i. No new dealership of that make shall be approved in the concerned district.

If a machine of particular, make is rejected with a score of > 300 “% chance for debarment” or any two dealers are debarred within a single district:

- ii. If above instances are detected across multiple districts for the particular, make:
The manufacturer shall be debarred from approval of new dealerships statewide.
- iii. The manufacturer shall be blocked for the State, if multiple dealers are blocked at district level for the particular make.

10.3 Monitoring and Evaluation: The Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha at his discretion may engage any **Third Party** or any Institution/ Organisation / Officer/ Group of Officers under the **Directorate of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha** for Post-Facto Verification/ Evaluation of the Farm Machineries/ Implements/ Equipment supplied under Farm Mechanisation DBT.

10.4 Monitoring and Enforcement by OFMRDC: Apart from conducting SLTC Meetings at regular intervals during a year for introduction/ popularisation of new and modern Machineries/ Implements / Equipment for use by the Farming Community of Odisha, the Development Engineer, OFMRDC, Bhubaneswar (in person or through his Engineering Personnel of OFMRDC) will visit each and all Manufacturing Units of all the Manufacturers/ Farms (who apply/applied for inclusion of new Machineries / Implements / Equipment in SLTC) having Manufacturing Units outside the territory of Odisha to ensure about the genuineness/ authenticity of Manufacturing Process and availability of adequate Infrastructure in the Manufacturing unit and Technical Specifications of the Machineries / Implements/ Equipment applied for.

For Manufacturers having Manufacturing units situated inside the State, the Development Engineer, OFMRDC, Bhubaneswar (in person or through the Executive Engineer (Agril.) of the respective District/ Division) will visit each and all Manufacturing Units of all the Manufacturers / Farms (who apply for inclusion of new Machineries/ Implements/ Equipment in SLTC) for the purpose as mentioned above.

Further in case a Manufacturer-id is blocked, the DE OFMRDC should mandatorily visit the unit and furnish his certificate with recommendation for unblocking subject to compliance of the details as mentioned above.

10.5 Monitoring and Enforcement by SLFMTTC: Apart from conducting Testing of Machineries/ Implements/ Equipment as per Test codes & provision thereof, the Director, SLFMTTC, Bhubaneswar (in person or through his Engineering Personnel of SLFMTTC) will cross check randomly the machines at Manufacturer premises/dealer point/farmer's place to ensure about the genuineness / authenticity of the quality and Technical Specifications of the Machineries / Implements / Equipment approved & enlisted through SLTC.

For Manufacturers having Manufacturing units situated inside the State, the Director, SLFMTTC, Bhubaneswar (in person or along with an engineer from SLFMTTC and the Executive Engineer (Agril.) of the respective District/ Division) will conduct the above checks.

Further in case a Manufacturer-id is blocked, the Director, SLFMTTC should mandatorily visit the unit/dealer point/farmer's place and furnish his certificate with recommendation for unblocking subject to compliance of the details as mentioned in above para.

10.6 The Director of Agriculture and Food Production, Odisha may at his discretion give instructions to the Chief Engineer (Agril.), O/o DA&FP, Odisha to visit (in person or through the Agriculture Engineers working under him) any or all Manufacturing Units (situated inside or outside the territory of Odisha) to inspect / verify the Manufacturing Process and availability of adequate Infrastructure in the Manufacturing unit and to ensure authenticity/ genuineness of the Technical Specifications or any other related issues of the Machineries/ Implements/ Equipment being popularized/ to be popularized in Odisha.

11. 1% of total allocation of the AAP of State may be earmarked for administrative and other contingent expenses.

11. Demonstration/Capacity building :

11.1 Demonstrate the impact of new technologies & disseminate or stimulate the neighbouring farmers to adopt the package: It is proposed to organize 4 Regional Melas District Level Mela in 26 districts (other than Regional Melas) & Sub-division level Mela at 28 Places (other than the district headquarters subdivision).

The Manufacturers through their Dealers will participate in the Melas with their SLTC approved Machineries/implements empanelled in DBT Implement portal, with sufficient inventory. Facilitate on the spot booking/payment transaction/supply of Agriculture machines / implements under subsidy to the farmers / SHGs / FPOs / FPCs with the support of financial institutions, PRI members, line departments and other stake holders.

For Regional Melas the budget will be @ Rs.100 lakhs/-.

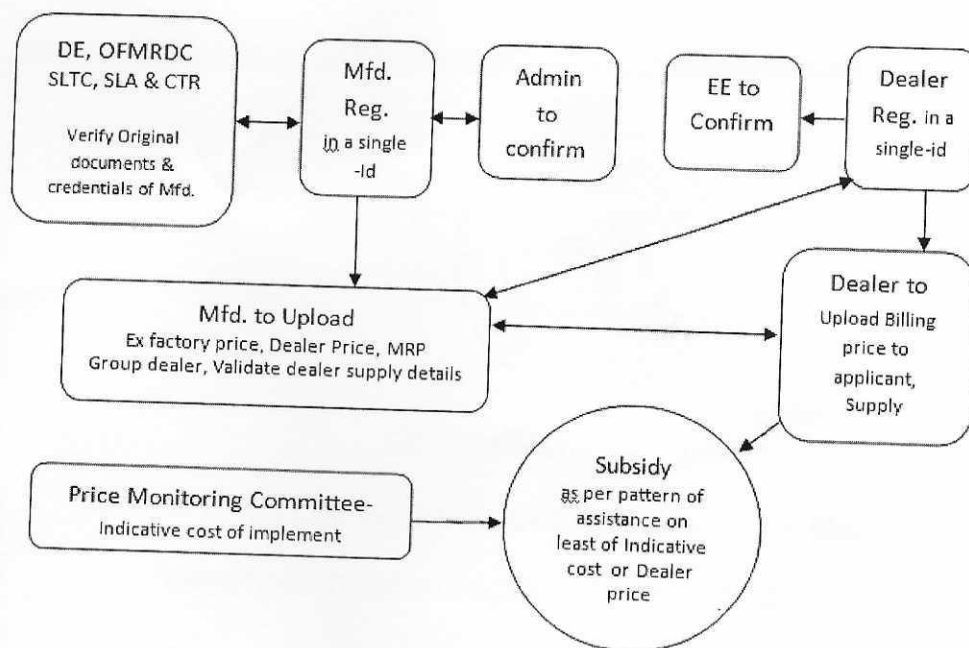

11.2 Manufacturers shall arrange demonstrations of their machines in accordance with the provisions of the Service Level Agreement (SLA), across the State and specifically in the districts of Deogarh, Nuapada, Kandhamal, Boudh, Rayagada, Gajapati, Sundargarh, Nabarangpur, Malkangiri, Koraput, Kalahandi, Dhenkanal, Bhadrak, Bolangir, Angul, and Keonjhar. These demonstrations will promote the rational use of machinery in consultation with the respective Executive Engineers (EE). Renewal of the SLA for each manufacturer shall be undertaken by the Development Engineer, OFMRDC, based on the report submitted by the concerned EE.
